•	Large 42 Passenger Activity Bus	\$100,000
•	Furniture in Primary Building	\$15,000
•	Acoustical Improvements in Auditorium	\$12,000
•	Classroom Sets of iPads (K-2)	\$9,600 (per classroom, set of 24)
