

**WCA will adhere to CollegeBoard requirements for all SAT and ACT testing on our campus, and we have implemented a new health screening process.**

Per current CollegeBoard requirements, **each student who tests at our center will need to wear a face mask while inside buildings (even while testing), and when distancing of at least (6) feet can't be maintained outside of our buildings.**

Contact and health screening information must be provided at check-in. Each student's temperature will be checked using a walk-through body temperature detector (please note that a temperature of 100.4 F or higher is considered a fever). **Prior to admittance, all students must be fever-free and provide accurate information and answers to the following questions:**

- 1. Name and contact information must be provided.**
- 2. Have you had close contact (within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes) in the last (14) days with someone diagnosed with COVID-19, or has any health department or health care provider been in contact with you and advised you to quarantine?**
- 3. Have you been diagnosed with COVID-19 within the past three weeks?**
- 4. In the past 48 hours, have you experienced any of these symptoms?**
  - Fever
  - Chills
  - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
  - New cough
  - Sore throat
  - New loss of taste of smell
- 5. During the last 14 days, have you been in close contact (within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes) with anyone experiencing the symptoms listed above?**
- 6. Have you traveled outside the country or to any high-risk locations within the last 14 days or been in close contact with someone who has traveled to a high-risk location within the past 14 days?**

***If you answer **YES** to any of the above questions, or if temperature of 100.4 F or higher is detected, you must leave WCA campus immediately and contact CollegeBoard or ACT to reschedule your test date.***
